Graded Symptom Scale Checklist

Modified from various published symptom checklists²⁷⁻³⁰

Evaluate <u>all</u> signs and symptoms, ranking each on a scale of 0-6. **Establish baseline score prior to the start of the athletic season.** After a concussive injury, re-assess the athlete for each symptom. Add columns and compare to baseline score. Only consider return to activity if scores are comparable to baseline score. Continue testing every 2-3 days if symptoms do not resolve. Use with SAC and/or BESS to determine appropriate time for return to play.
